A GRAND LADY OF VIRGINIA COMES TO WASHINGTON DC

WASHINGTON DC, OCTOBER 1 2008: After more than 50 years of gracefully entertaining guests at the historic luxury hotel, The Tides Inn, the Miss Ann is coming to Washington DC this Sunday.

The Miss Ann, a 127 foot luxury fantail motor yacht, was built in the 1920's. Built to entertain guests and family of John French, a Detroit industrialist, she incorporated all the fine furnishings of the time. When the United States entered WWII she served our country as the Aquamarine, patrolling local waters and conducting experiments in underwater sound and communication technologies. Additionally she tendered the presidential yachts Potomac and Williamsburg. She was renovated in the 1950's when purchased by Ennolls Stevens of the Tides Inn and still retains the grace and character of that bygone era.



Miss Ann now comes to Washington DC to entertain guests on the Potomac River in the style of that bygone era. Moored at the Gangplank Marina along Washington Channel, she is available for private charter cruises. Weekend public cruises are planned for this fall.
